Student Conduct


- ✓ Students should not be up and walking around during class time.

Assignments

All assignments will be due when the teacher posts the due date on Google Classrooms.

In order to turn in book work, students/parents will be required to take a picture of the assignment and upload to Google Classroom. Tutorials will be posted on the website.

Duo learning refers to a learning activity in which students are engaging in learning at the same time. These learning activities are REAL TIME (Live) and indicate what students need to do/submit within class time. Virtual learners will be expected to participate in several synchronous learning activities throughout the week. To do this, virtual learners must:

- Wear their Ovell's Christian Academy uniform while engaging in live lessons. This is important as it will show that they are part of the school community while participating as a virtual learner.
- Connect through ZOOM/Google Meets at the designated time by the teacher to participate in Live lessons/tests/quizzes etc.

- □ Be punctual. Teachers are required to let students into the classroom, please be sure to be in the virtual waiting room at least five minutes before the live lesson is going to begin.
 - Virtual learners are expected to complete all synchronous activities with the class.

- ☐ Students are expected follow Zoom/Google Meets Guidelines*.
- If a student does not participate or sign in to a live lesson, he or she will be considered absent. Live lessons will not be recorded.
